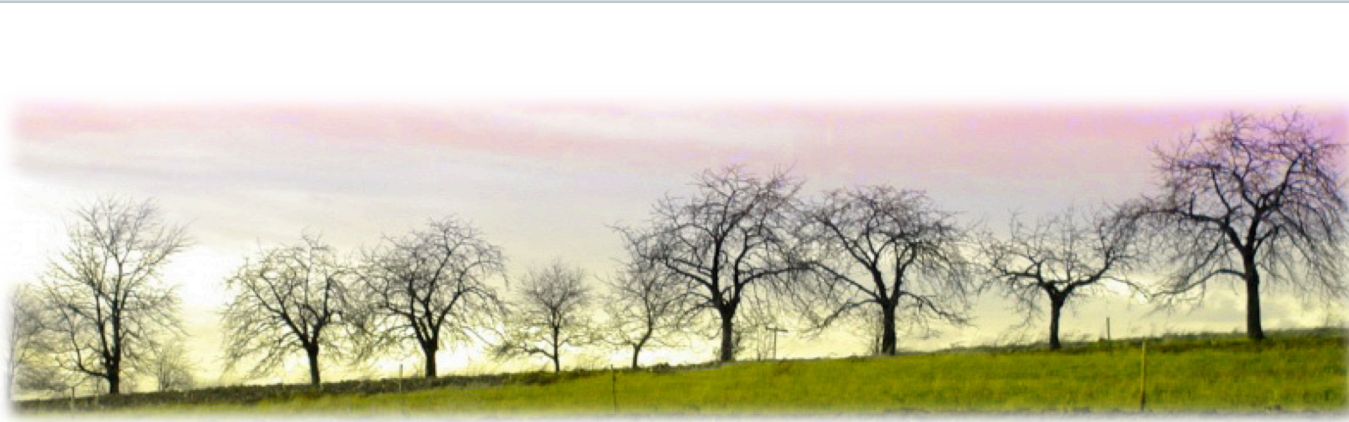

What is a SELPA?

A Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA) is a group of school districts and County Office of Education that join together to form a geographic region to provide all of the special education service needs for children with disabilities residing within the region's boundaries. In Marin County, the SELPA consists of all of the local school districts and the Marin County Office of Education. The Marin SELPA is a support service office. The SELPA is responsible to ensure that programs and services are available to meet the needs of students with disabilities from birth through age 22 in Marin County.

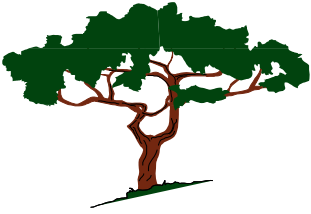
WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF SEAC?
